1. You must live in Montgomery County to register for classes.

5. Go there in person to register & get tested.
6. If there is no room in the class for you, we will put your name on a waiting list for another class.
7. Students in GED level classes **must** pay tuition.
8. All students purchase their own textbooks.

You will learn about classes and the GED exam, how long it takes to prepare, what you need to do to register for classes or the GED Test. You do not need to register for this event. The meeting includes time for questions and answers. **We strongly recommend that you go to a session.** Attending does **not** mean you are registered for classes.
